Recommendations to Get You Started

Once you are ready to start a local chapter, decide what innovators or supporters of innovation on your campus you would like to recognize. For example, you have the option to only induct faculty with patents, or you may induct faculty, staff, students and affiliates.

- 1. Please share with NAI staff how many individuals you initially plan to induct and we will mail you one custom NAI lapel pin for each new individual member.
- 2. We are happy to share any press releases for the event with our membership via the NAI newsletter, website and social media outlets as requested.
- 3. Send us the email addresses of your members once you have formed a chapter, so we may add them to our email list to receive further information about the NAI.
- 4. We recommend planning an inaugural event, such as a luncheon or reception, to launch your chapter. It provides a focal point and deadline for inviting your inventors to become members of the chapter, and a public opportunity to recognize and celebrate their achievements, and the achievements of your research enterprise.
- 5. If you would like to invite a member of the <u>NAI Board of Directors</u> to attend your event, send a detailed formal request to Lauren Maradei at <u>Imaradei@academyofinventors.org</u>

New Member Application Form Template. This form is helpful if you would like to make your chapter open for your faculty to apply for membership. This form is not required (nor does it need to be submitted to the NAI), but you may find it provides assistance with recruiting new members and capturing their information. This template can be modified with your institution's name, logo and leadership for new individual inventor members to complete.

Certificate of Membership Templates

The certificates are intended to be personalized by you and presented to each new member of your chapter, along with their membership lapel pin. There are two membership categories for Chapters of the NAI:

I. **Members:** academic inventors at your institution who hold an issued U.S. patent(s). Your chapter may choose to recognize all inventors at your institution (faculty, staff, students, alumni and affiliates) or only those who have an issued patent(s) from your institution. Additional criteria for membership in your chapter is defined by your institutional representatives.

II. **Honorary Members:** leadership and representatives of your institution and local community who have facilitated and nurtured innovation and economic development (who do not hold patents themselves). This is a great way to recognize your president, vice presidents, members of your local federal delegation etc. for their support and efforts in fostering a spirit of innovation at your institution.
