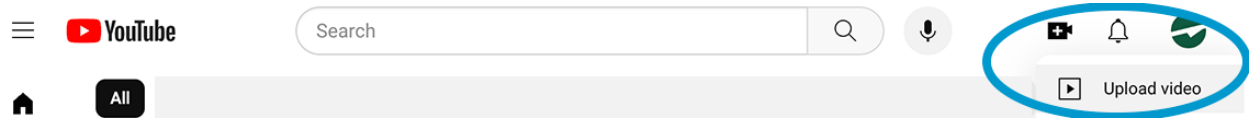


Uploading Your Video to YouTube

1. While logged into your account, navigate to YouTube and click the image in the top right of the page that looks like a camera, then click “Upload video”



2. Drag or select your video to upload



Drag and drop video files to upload

Your videos will be private until you publish them.

3. Set the video title and description

4. Scroll down under Audience and select “No, it's not made for kids”

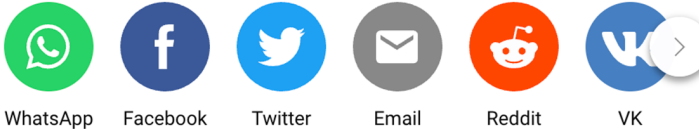

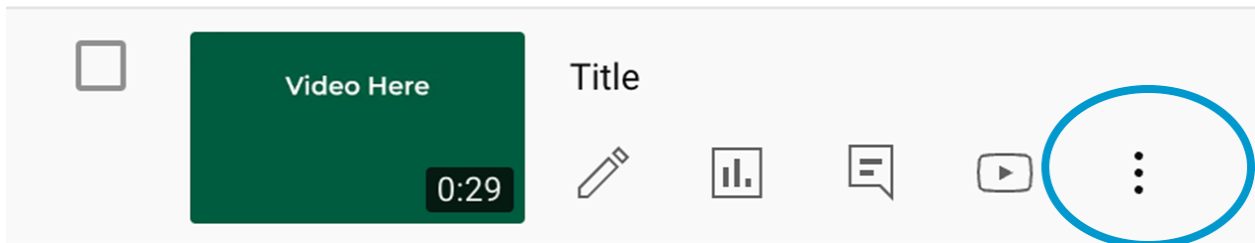
